background: This product is an unconjugated, non-therapeutic recombinant analog of the anti-PD-1 antibody pucotenlimab (a human IgG4-kappa immunoglobulin), supplied strictly for research use only. It is not the clinical drug and is not intended for human or veterinary use. Built around the human PD-1 (PDCD1) target, it reproduces the binding specificity of the originator molecule, making it a useful reagent for laboratory investigation of the PD-1/PD-L1 checkpoint axis. Typical research applications include use as a positive binding control, as a reference antibody in blockade and neutralization assays, in flow cytometry and ELISA-based receptor-occupancy work, and as a starting reagent for biosimilar characterization or antibody-engineering pipelines. The material is offered at research grade with low endotoxin (1 EU/mg; ultra-low 0.5 EU/mg options), and is available in bulk milligram-to-gram quantities to support in-vitro assay development and preclinical workflows. Because it is delivered unconjugated, it can be paired with the labels, secondary detection systems, or downstream conjugation chemistries a given experiment requires. PD-1 (programmed cell death protein 1; gene PDCD1, UniProt Q15116) is a type I transmembrane immunoinhibitory receptor of the CD28/CTLA-4 family, expressed on activated T cells, B cells, NK cells, and other immune subsets. Its extracellular IgV domain engages two ligands, PD-L1 (CD274) and PD-L2 (CD273). Ligand binding clusters PD-1 at the immunological synapse and triggers phosphorylation of its cytoplasmic ITIM and ITSM motifs, which recruit the phosphatase SHP-2 (and SHP-1). These phosphatases

dephosphorylate proximal TCR and CD28 signaling components, dampening T-cell activation, proliferation, and cytokine output. Physiologically this maintains peripheral tolerance and limits immunopathology, but tumors and chronically infected tissues exploit the pathway to drive T-cell exhaustion. Antibodies that block PD-1 relieve this inhibition and restore effector function, the rationale underlying checkpoint-blockade research.

Formulation: Sterile, preservative-free, solution in PBS. BSA and Azide free.

Storage: This biosimilar is stable when stored at 2-8°C. For longer term storage (> 3 months) it is recommended to store this antibody at -20°C or -70°C.
